CHANGES IN RESPONSES AT MASS: *I confess ...*

The translation of the Confiteor that will appear in the new edition of Missal will have a few changes to what we have been saying since 1975. The most obvious change will be the use of the words "*through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault*". This was already retained in the Irish language translation of this prayer. The use of triplets is often employed in Latin and this was not always translated in the texts we currently use. A word not translated in the current Missal is now translated as "greatly" giving us the new phrase "*that I have greatly sinned*". This has its biblical roots in the words of David in 1 Chronicles 21:8. "David said to God, 'I have sinned greatly in that I have done this thing...'"
