**CHANGES IN RESPONSES AT MASS:** *May the Lord accept...and the good of all his holy Church.* This response remains unchanged except for the addition of the word *holy* in the end phrase. This word appears in the Latin text and so is being added to the English text.

**Preface dialogue:** The change in the response to *The Lord be with you as And with your spirit* has already been noted. The only other change in this dialogue is the final response which is what is found in the Latin *It is right and just*. These words are taken up by the Priest as he continues the Eucharistic Prayer with the Preface itself: *It is truly right and just*.

**Holy, Holy, Holy Lord (Sanctus):** The only change to this text is the phrase *"Lord God of hosts"* instead of "God of power and might". "Hosts" or "armies" are the usual translations of the Hebrew word *Saboath*. Here it means the "heavenly hosts of angels" – a phrase that we are familiar with from the second verse of our Christmas hymn "Silent Night".
