CHANGES IN RESPONSES AT MASS: *Memorial Acclamation* The introduction is now simply the words *The Mystery of Faith* - a straightforward translation of the Latin text.

The 1975 Missal gave us five acclamations, including *My Lord and My God* which was included "for Ireland only". In the new edition of the Missal for Ireland we find four acclamations. The first acclamation is a new translation of the Latin text that the acclamations *Christ has died...* and *Dying you destroyed our death...* were both based upon. These familiar acclamations do not appear as they are not direct translations of the Latin. Also *Christ has died...* contains statements about Christ rather than, more suitably, being addressed to Christ.

There is almost no change in the second acclamation (*When we eat this Bread...*) and in the third acclamation (now beginning, *Save us, Saviour of the world*) there is a change to the current word order. The acclamation *My Lord and my God* is included for Ireland.

REPORT FROM PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING (1) It was reported that the Diocesan Pastoral Council is setting up a group to develop a framework and principles for the development of Pastoral Areas (i.e. parishes working together). It is planned to have a general meeting of Parishioners to discuss this and other matters next Spring. (2) The members of the Pastoral Council are invited to 3 nights training in Mullinavat on 7th, 14th & 21st November for Pastoral Councils in the Southern Deanery. (3) It is planned to have a Christmas Tree in the car park in Kilmoganny and to have a ceremony of switching on the lights and singing of Christmas Carols on **Friday 16th December at 7.00 p.m.** followed by a cup of tea etc in St. Eoghan's Centre. (5) A special mass will be celebrated in St. Mary's Cathedral, Kilkenny on Sunday 13th November at 3.00 p.m. to introduce the New Missal and present the Ossory Banner.
