**CHANGES IN RESPONSES AT MASS:** *Memorial Acclamation* The introduction is now simply the words *The Mystery of Faith* - a straightforward translation of the Latin text.

The 1975 Missal gave us five acclamations, including My Lord and My God which was included "for Ireland only". In the new edition of the Missal for Ireland we find four acclamations. The first acclamation is a new translation of the Latin text that the acclamations Christ has died... and Dying you destroyed our death... were both based upon. These familiar acclamations do not appear as they are not direct translations of the Latin. Also Christ has died... contains statements about Christ rather than, more suitably, being addressed to Christ.

There is almost no change in the second acclamation (*When we eat this Bread*...) and in the third acclamation (now beginning, *Save us, Saviour of the world*) there is a change to the current word order. The acclamation *My Lord and my God* is included for Ireland.
