**PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING REPORT** (1) Thanks was expressed to all those who assisted and attended the evening of Devotion associated with the Eucharistic Congress Bell; (2) Ideas are welcomed as to the form and frequency of types of devotions which could be held in the Church; (3) Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> June is the day on which the Diocese of Ossory invites members of the Diocese to attend the Congress. People are free to attend on other days. (4) The Bishop intends to consult with Priests and Parish Pastoral Councils re the best way of serving the pastoral need of the people of the diocese into the future. (5) A **meeting of all parishioners** from the parish will take place on **Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> March in St. Eoghan's Centre, Kilmoganny at 8.00 p.m.** It is important that parishioners attend this meeting as all views and opinions are important in planning the future development. (6) In 10 years time there could be 9 priests less than the number of parishes in the diocese. The diocese is planning for this development at present. (7) An increase in priestly vocation is very necessary.
