PARISH MEETING OF PARISHIONERS: Some of the information given at the meeting: (1) The population of the 4 largest parishes in the Diocese almost equals the population of the 20 least populated parishes; (2) In less than 10 years there will be 10 fewer priests under 75 than the number of parishes (42) in the diocese; (3) Changes to cater for the future in the diocese will commence this summer; (4) The bishop is consulting with priests and parish councils; (5) A report was given on the Parish Pastoral Council's activities during the past three years; (6) When changes do occur the obvious impact will be on a reduction of week-end masses in Parishes and a possible greater reduction during the time when priests are on holidays; (7) If and when changes impact on Dunamaggan parish a meeting of parishioners will be held.
