# Autumn courses in Droichead Family Resource Centre, The Friary, Callan:

A **Stonemason course** will begin on Wednesday, Oct 10<sup>th</sup> and will run for 10 Wednesdays. It will take place in the Abbey Meadow from 9am – 4.30pm. The cost of the course is €20 and is run in partnership with Kilkenny VEC and Droichead FRC.
