**WINDGAPDEFIBRILLATOR NEWS:** To date we have purchased three defibrillators and three specialised boxes to house the defibrillators. They have been installed in the following locations: (1) on the wall at the door to the left, at the top of the long steps at Windgap N.S. (2) on the front porch of the Parochial House in Windgap Village, (3) on the front wall of Tullahought Community Centre.

AED Training has been provided for 47 people from the locality. We have decided to hold two Annual Cake and Home Produce Sales as a means of funding on-going training, maintenance and the erection of permanent signage etc. **The first sale will take place on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> August after the Cemetery Mass in Windgap.** We would greatly appreciate if you could support this fund-raiser by bringing cakes, home produce (jams, vegetables, etc) or by making a donation to the fund, please.
