THE MISCARAGE ASSOCIATION OF IRELAND will hold its first national support group meeting in Kilkenny on 17th October 2013, 7pm in St Patrick's Parish Centre, Bohernatounish Road, Loughboy. The Association, which celebrates 25 years in existence this year, provides support to all who have been affected by miscarriage through a telephone support service, monthly support meetings in Dublin's Buswell's Hotel, and an annual Service of Remembrance, which will take place this year on 10th November, at 3 pm in St Theresa's church, Donore Avenue (off South Circular Road) Dublin 8.
