**A YOUTH PILGRIMAGE TO TAIZÉ** in France organised by Ossory Youth and under the patronage of the Bishop of Ossory will take place from 16<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>th</sup> August 2015. This is the third consecutive year that Ossory Youth has organised the pilgrimage and a maximum number of 25 young people from the Diocese accompanied by four leaders from Ossory Youth will depart on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> August. Amazingly about 3,000 other young people from throughout most countries in Europe will also spend that weekend travelling to Taizé to spend the next week together. Over 100,000 young people from around the world make a pilgrimage to Taizé each year.

The pilgrimage is open to Transition year, 5<sup>th</sup> year and Leaving Cert students and **the closing date for applications is Fri 13<sup>th</sup> Feb 2015.** The overall pilgrimage programme will run from February to August with regular group meetings at two to three weekly intervals. The cost is €500 with the young people also expected to participate in group fundraising initiatives. This cost includes flights (Dublin to Lyon) and coach transfers to/from Taizé. It also includes all accommodation and meals in Taizé.
